GRILL NIGHT VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES



GRILL NIGHTS EVERY WEDNESDAY 6/7/2023 – 10/4/2023

UPON ARRIVAL:

Please plan to arrive at 5:00pm to begin setting up.

- 1. Open the clubhouse and both kitchen doors.
- 2. Open windows in the kitchen and both bathrooms.
- 3. Move the grill outside and connect both propane tanks. One on each side. Propane tanks are found in the gray container to the right of the kitchen stairs/deck.
- 4. Move the rolling, plastic, 3-tier cart outside next to the grill.
- 5. Place cooking, and grill cleaning utensils (found under the left-hand sink) on cart.
- 6. As people start to arrive, light the grill, keep on high setting, let burn for 10-12 minutes, then clean. After the grill surface is clean, turn temperature setting down to low. Those using the grill will adjust temperature to accommodate what they are grilling.

CLOSING:

- 1. Shut off grill and remove both propane tanks. <u>It is illegal, and a violation of every fire</u> code to store propane tanks inside.
- 2. Let the grill cool and replace the cover. Grill needs to be covered and rolled back inside the clubhouse.
- 3. Return the rolling cart back into the club and wash any cooking utensils used by members for cooking. You are only responsible for washing those common items. Individual members are responsible for any plates, glasses, or silverware they used.
- 4. At the end of the evening, please close and lock all windows and doors to the. If for some reason you are unable to close the club, please ask another member if they are willing to do this for you.
